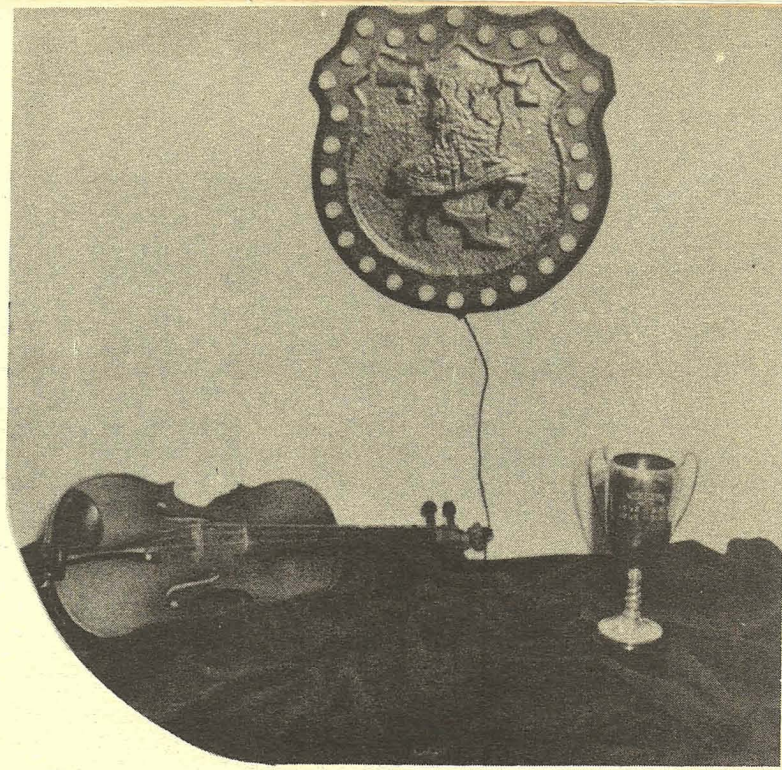
A Prayer Band meets
