I was Principal of Maplewood Boarding Academy Maple Flain for the first two years of its history.

The school opened in September 1904, with a curriculum comparable to that offered in any high school, rlus piano instruction and eccourses in Bible study.

Unbelievable as it may seem, a student's expense in those days, and living in the dormitory, was only ten dollars per month; which included board, room, tuition, laundry, etc. with a catalogue proviso that each student must contribute two hours work, each day under proper direction and supervision, whether the work assigned be in the culinary department, the laundry, or on the ninety acre farm which furnished much food for the school - milk cream- butter- truit vegetables etc. The Academy 1st year dored with Bauh Account vegetables etc. The Academy 1st year dored with Bauh Account vegetables etc.

Buring the years I acted as principal and taught the Bible course, the following persons were associated members of the Marle-wood Faculty.

H. J. Sheldon, Miss Caroline Hopkins, Miss Wavie Tubbs,
Mrs Myrtle Bernstein, Miss Lena Rosenthal, Halph Campbell
and Samuel Jackson.

To this staff of efficient instructors may be credited the laying of foundation principles which have made Maplewood an outstanding school of it's kind.

The Christian influence of this group of instructors on the individual student out side the class room, was so marked that during those first two years that we had scarcely any cases of discipline for infraction of the rule: Academy rules.

Each student was relaced on his honor -- Teachers are students studied together, played together, and ate together (but not in Cafeteria style .)

Our taffy pulls, our spelling bees, our evenings of social entertainment . the hours of recreation in Entitioners (or election)

will always bring back bright memories .

From the beginning Maplewood Academy has had an enviable record of achievement. It has notyonly provided high school education or a very inexpensive basis but with it's courses completed has sent out into the world hundreds of young men and women pretty well equipped to meet life's responsibilities.

Now Here's one for the book--

It was past Il P. M.- Lights had been put out an hour earlier.

The Academy family lay peacefully asleep amidst the Maplewoods on this glorious Indian Summer moonlight night.

I had arisen to take, my occasional midnight look-around to assure my-self that all was well.

In the Chapel, where so often we had prayed for wisdom and guift ance in fulfilling the trust the school board and parents, imposed uror us, I found but a sacred silence stillness.

As I was passing down toward the dining hall I heard a rustling noise :or didn't I ?

Flashing my light here and there, I discovered over in the dining room corner, a student couple "holding "a conference. Such meetings, however especially when held at night, were contrary to Academy rules but I said nothing and passed along.

Returning a few minutes later however I found the meeting had adjourned.

The night bassed- the sun ushered in a " Good- Morning " and as usual the school it's daily program .

There were no calls to the "Prof's " office !

There was no meeting of the faculty

There was no " pack your trunk " order

But I know there were two very anxious,

Days passed extremely nervous students- expectantly waiting.

Allet them wait - waiting you know gives time for thought, while silence often administers rebuke.

The Wise Man wrote Eccl 3: 7 - " There is a time to keep still ".

We proved it good counsel in this instance. The students of our story became a model pair and later a Bridal Fair. He became a successful preacher, and " she " tells their children what a worderfall Faculty Maplewood Academy had, when they were students.
