

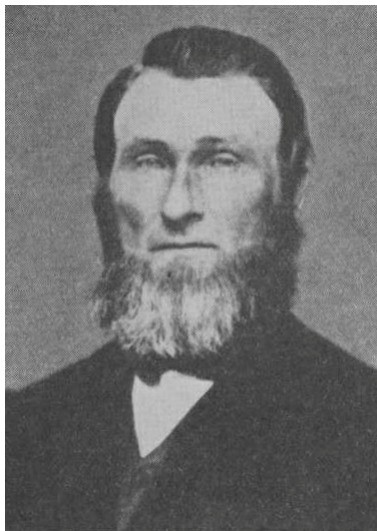
Tuesday's Trivia Question

Trivia Question:

On whose farm was the first Minnesota Seventh-day Adventist camp meeting held in 1869?

Answer:

The first two Minnesota Seventh-day Adventist camp meetings were held on the farm of Elder William Ingraham in Wasioja (near Dodge Center). Ingraham, originally from Vermont, was one of the earliest SDA ministers in Minnesota where he walked many miles around the state, sharing the Advent gospel with the settlers in the new state.
