## Trivia Question:

**During the 1800s, what location was used most frequently for Minnesota camp meetings?**

## Answer:

**The newly developed Pleasant Park area (east of Lake Harriet on Nicollet Avenue) in Minneapolis was used six years (1889-1894). Not far behind it in use, however, were Pierce's Grove on Lake Calhoun in Minneapolis (five years, 1879-1883) and Straight River Park in Medford (four years, 1871-1874).**
