Trivia Question:

For several decades, the Minnesota Conference constituency meeting was held during camp meeting (usually the last Sunday). What camp meeting year did the Minnesota Conference determine at this annual business meeting to open a “conference school” which became the forerunner of Maplewood Academy?

Answer:

In 1888, camp meeting was held at Minnehaha Falls in Minneapolis. At the annual business meeting that followed camp meeting, the Minnesota Conference voted to open a “conference school” in the new Minneapolis church. This school, the “Minnesota Preparatory School,” was opened November 14, 1888 following the General Conference meetings held in the church.
