The Gilchrist SDA Church started in 1880 as a Scandinavian congregation. Which member became a missionary in 1945 to Bechuanaland (now Botswana), South Africa?

Answer:



Myrtle Sather, a graduate of Hutchinson Theological Seminary and St. Helena Sanitarium, began service in 1945 as a missionary nurse in Bechuanaland where she helped develop medical facilities and a nursing program. In 1956, an era when women did not usually hold high administrative posts in the church, Sather was

appointed as the Medical Secretary of the Southern African Division, the first nurse to hold this position at a division level.
